

EAST TN ANGUS FIELD DAY JUNIOR SHOW RULES

There is no minimum age for any junior wishing to show. The maximum age is 21 years old as of January 1, 2011. The show is open to any junior that would like to bring their registered animal to the show. **Make sure the registration papers are complete. All registration papers must be in the junior's name. Junior members must have the original papers to participate in the show.**

Rules:

- Age classifications are by the National Junior Show Rules; but, will also include January and February of 2011 bred and owned heifer(s) and bull calves.
- Must be an active Junior Angus member
- Animal must be in the juniors name by May 15m of current year (issue date, not date of sell)

Showmanship Classes:

- Novice – grades 3 and under
- Junior – grades 4 – 6
- Junior High – grades 7 – 9
- Senior – grades 10 and above

Bring the following information to the Field Day:

- Original Registration Papers (NO COPIES)
- Up-to-date health papers by TN Animal Health Guidelines

Grooming is optional

Heifers, Bred & Owned Bulls, Cows with Bred & Owned calves and Steers are accepted. All animals must be registered through the American Angus Association.
